

Call for Papers – ZDMG (Section: Islamic Studies) – 2026

The *Zeitschrift der Deutschen Morgenländischen Gesellschaft* (ZDMG), one of the oldest academic journals dedicated to research on the Near East, Asia, and Africa, invites the submission of original and innovative contributions to the field of Islamic Studies for publication in volumes 177.2 (2027) and 178.1 (2028).

Submissions may take the form of full-length articles (up to 70,000 characters, including abstract, footnotes, and spaces) or shorter contributions (up to 16,000 characters). Detailed submission guidelines, including formatting and the list of standard abbreviations, are available at <https://dmg-web.de/en/publications/author-guidelines/>.

We particularly welcome articles with a historical orientation grounded in philological analysis. Contributions should focus on pre-modern Muslim societies (up to approximately 1800 CE) and address topics such as history, religion, culture, law, literature, or social structures.

Articles may be submitted in English, German, or French. Arabic terms should be transliterated using the DMG system (see <https://dmg-web.de/en/publications/transliteration-of-the-arabic-script/>) and modern personal names should be written in small caps.

All submissions will be subject to editorial review for scholarly quality and formal compliance. Selected articles will be peer-reviewed and published in the aforementioned volumes.

Manuscripts should be submitted by **15 October 2026** to Prof. Dr. Jens Scheiner at jschein@uni-goettingen.de. Submissions received after this date may be considered for future volumes, including those announced in the 2027 call for papers.
